It is our policy to reduce, reuse and recycle as much material as possible and continue to find innovative ways to protect the environment through the processes that we have put in place.

### **Our Actions**

#### **2019**

- We started using Biogas to run our forklift trucks

#### **2020**

- We introduced electric vehicles for our event managers to use and installed two EV charging stations on site

#### **2021**

- We purchased a marquee cleaning machine to cut down on water waste and prolong the life span of our marquee canvas
- Installation of LED lighting into our office and canteen

#### **2022**

- Installed a recycling system within our warehouse and office.
- Provided a filtered water supply in the canteen for staff to refill water bottles instead of bringing in single use plastic bottles

#### **2023**

- started trials on HVO fuel in our heaters and generators
- All hired marquee lighting is LED

#### **2024**

- started our carpet recycling policy by changing supplier and using their recycling in house recycling system.

### **2025**

- To install solar panels on our roof
- Continue to install LED lighting throughout our warehouse
- To utilise energy as efficiently as possible by adopting good energy housekeeping practices.
- To develop and publish clear targets for energy consumption annually and to report progress against the previous year.
- To track and monitor our carbon footprint

### **2026**

- To work towards gaining accreditation ISO14001 & ISO9001 & Other credible associations that promote good sustainability polices that will help us improve further our goals
- To design in energy efficiency to buildings, refurbishments and equipment.
- To increase the energy awareness of staff and employees.
- To procure goods and services from organisations who demonstrate a positive commitment to energy efficiency where it is practical and cost effective to do so.
- To use sub-contractors with a similar policy to our own
